

FIX'N WAG'N Feline Low Cost Spay/Neuter

Please Read Carefully!

Tri-County Animal Rescue Center has partnered with Fix'n Wag'n to provide low cost spay/neuter clinics in our area. Please note that registration will now take place through Fix'n Wag'n online. Thank you for registering your cat to be spayed or neutered. Not only do veterinarians recommend cats be spayed and neutered to help prevent certain medical conditions, but you will also reduce the risk of spraying and other unwanted behaviors, and help us reduce the overwhelming overpopulation of cats. Below is some general information for you to keep as a reference as you prepare for the clinic as well as a detailed step by step tutorial on how to complete the registration.

General Information

Included in the **\$90** fee are: Surgery, Rabies (1 year) and FVRCP (distemper combo) vaccines, flea preventative, ear mite treatment (if needed) and nail trim. For **FERAL CATS in TRAPS ONLY**, both Profender and an ear tip are also included but you must select **Feral Cat Add Ons** when you register your cat. You can purchase additional services which you can select while you are registering your cat.

Some notes for clients so you are not caught off guard:

*****If a cat is found to have fleas or tapeworms, Fix'N Wag'N will automatically treat with Capstar (\$7.50) and Droncit (\$7.50, unless Profender is also purchased during registration), which will be an additional charge at check out. If a cat is found to have Flea Allergy Dermatitis (FAD), Fix'N Wag'N will automatically treat with Convenia (\$25), which will be an additional charge at check out. Also, if your cat is found to have any other conditions that may require treatment the staff with Fix'n Wag'n will call and additional payments could be required at check out.*****

Instructions for Clinic: MUST BE FOLLOWED!

1. Please sign the electronic consent, sent by Fix'n Wag'n, as soon as you receive the email to make the clinic run smoothly. Be sure to fill out everything, so read carefully!
2. **Drop off is between 7:30 and 8:30 AM the day of the clinic.**
3. Your cat(s) cannot have food or treats after midnight the night before. They may have water.
4. Your cat must be in a sturdy carrier (**one cat per carrier**). Hard carriers are preferred. **NO wire crates. You MUST put your name, the cat's name and your phone number for that day on the carrier** (a piece of paper securely taped on is fine). **If the cat is feral, it MUST be in a trap.**
5. Pick up is between 5:00 and 5:30 PM that afternoon. The time may vary slightly, depending on the length of time surgeries take that day. **You just show up, we do not call.** If you are late, there is a \$5 fee every half hour.
6. Another note...if your cat requires any medications an additional fee may be due at the time of pick up.

Step by Step Registration Instructions
