Requirements:

- 18+ years old, responsible & reliable
- Available to work year round with reliable transportation
- Comfortable working around/willing to handle nervous dogs with care
- Comfortable and physically capable of handling large, strong breed dogs
- Able to perform and work effectively both independently and in a group
- Comfortable communicating with others, including new volunteers, potential adopters and members of the public.

Job Description

- Feeding (following feeding chart)/providing fresh water and bedding
- Scooping poop and cleaning/sanitizing animal living quarters following shelter protocols
- Laundry and dishes
- Customer service (answering phones, greeting visitors)
- Socializing the animals
- Knowledge of animal behavior and comfortable handling stressed dogs
- Knowledge on our spay and neuter clinics
- Taking dogs outside twice during scheduled shift
- Administering medication and wound/medical care when needed and documenting on medication sheets
- Keeping kennel area clear of hazards and properly stocked
- Training new employees and volunteers as needed
- Supervising volunteers on your scheduled shift/hours
- Maintaining good communication with dog team
- Showing dogs to potential adopters
- Learn about animal behavior and help reduce stress while working with the dogs
